

Coulisses: Isobel & November vocalist Per-Erik Söderberg goes solo



Bearded baritone Per-Erik Söderberg is currently rehearsing for the recording of a solo album, slated for release in early November 2011. A more bare-boned, naked, sound is to be expected, especially when compared to his day-job with psych/post-rockers Isobel & November.

The songs to be released under the moniker of Coulisses have actually been in the making since as far back as 2002. Back then the idea was to write instrumental songs inspired by European and American folk music as well as movie soundtracks. Some of this is still an inspiration, but in its current state Coulisses has grown into a vehicle of Per-Erik Söderberg's inner self, with his trademark vocals and lyrics leading the way.

Extensive recording sessions will be taking place during August and September at The Pool Studio in London, a very high-end establishment which has housed the likes of Patrick Wolf, The Horrors, Iron And Wine and many more. Producer Mattias Beijmo has made a mission statement that one goal of the recording is to "make an album that will arouse PJ Harvey".

Although planning to go all out with this solo project, Per-Erik states that Isobel & November still has the same priority and that Coulisses is to be seen as a supplement rather than a substitute to his expression in the band.
